- Mr. Lozano

- Terry Vasquez, Secretary – time was allowed for all to review the minutes from 2/2/10 meeting. Motion to accept made by Julie Eakle. 2nd motion to accept made by James Boston. All in attendance accepted the minutes.
- Letty Lozano, Treasurer, went over the financial report. Financial report beginning balance was \$7,071.48, with deposits totaling \$745.07. This totaled \$7,816.55. Expenditures totaled \$2,920.81. Ending balance as of 3/2/10 is \$4,895.74. Motion to accept made by Ann Marie Carlton. 2nd motion to accept made by Larry Ramirez. All in attendance accepted the financial report.
- 1st VP (Dan Lueck in the absence of Laura Evans) – Rummage and plate sale will be on May 8th, 2010. Tickets for the plate sale will be distributed to students the week after Spring Break. Money for tickets will be due by April 9th.
 - Mr. Lozano – it is a mandatory requirement for students to sell a minimum of 6 tickets for the upcoming plate sale. If money is not turned in by April 9th, that student will not be permitted to participate in the 2010 Fiesta events (Battle of the Bands on 4/22 and Battle of Flowers Parade on 4/23). Tickets will be sold for \$6.00 each.
- Calendar sales are still going on. As of today, sale profit has not broken even with the expense. In order to recover what was spent in the making of the calendars, 39 additional calendars need to be sold.
- Dickey’s Barbecue fundraiser is on Wednesday, March 3rd, 6:00pm-9:00pm. Dickey’s Barbecue is located on Bandera near Eckert.
- Band Boosters will be working concession for the District Track Meet on Thursday, April 15th, in the afternoon. Time is uncertain, but it will start between 12:30 and 1:30 in the afternoon. A minimum of 13 volunteers are needed. Since this is during the school day, the volunteers will need to be made up entirely by parents. Event will be at Gus Stadium at Culebra/410.
- Coke Fundraiser sales will be from April 5th – May 4th. Coke products will be delivered on May 11th. Flyers and order forms will be distributed to students.
- **April Booster Meeting will be on April 13th at 7:00.** Date was pushed back a week due to UIL competitions.
- Laura Luna, 2nd VP – parents will be needed to help during the Battle of Flowers Parade on April 23rd. More to follow at the April meeting.
- Dan Lueck, President – By-laws were posted on-line following the February Booster meeting. By-laws are in effect as of today, March 2, 2010.
